

JENENE'S RCM 1 REPORT for February 7, 2016

Regional Service Committee Report from January 8th and 9th, 2016, Ellensburg, WA

1. Start-up meeting for 2017 Clean and Free is scheduled for Sunday February 21st, 2016 at 10:00 a.m. at 11307 Bridgeport Way SW Lakewood, WA in the same room and location that the current Clean and Free Host Committee Meeting meets in. Over 20+ positions open. Please share with everyone in your home groups - this is a wonderful service opportunity!
2. The start-up meeting for WNIRCNA 2017 (Seattle) is scheduled for Saturday, February 20th, 2016 at 2:00 p.m. at the SeaTac Marriott Hotel.
3. This year is a Conference Agenda Report (CAR) and all members needs to go online at www.na.org/conference and fill out the "Literature Survey." This is part of the 2016 (CAR).
4. The CAR, along with the summary videos are available for download from the Conference web page: www.na.org/conference. In addition to the fourteen motions (two from the World Board and twelve presented by individual regions) and survey, the CAR contains essays on the Fellowship Intellectual Property Trust, the future of zones and the World Service Conference, (WSC) and the service system. You are encouraged to familiarize yourself with all of the content. Also, along with the CAR, a packet of material related to the role of zones and the future of the WSC. That material is all available online at www.na.org/future.
5. Our Regional Delegates will be giving a presentation of the CAR at Clean and Free in March. This is another opportunity to familiarize yourself with these motions so that we can, with input from as many members as possible, take an informed vote at our Area Service Committee in March 2016.
6. Jenene asked if George could please put these links on our gh.na.org website for easier access to the CAR and survey for everyone.
7. It was decided that at the next ASC in March, we will see if members have had enough time to review this information, or if they would like to wait until after Clean and Free (where there will be a CAR presentation by our Regional Delegates) and vote at ASC in April, before Jenene and LuAnne go to RSC on April 9th and 10th, 2016.

8. Jenene gave John the current PI Contingency Plan from the Regional PI Chair, Ray. (What to do if the media contacts you).

9. Jenene handed out Pre-Registration for WNIRCNA XXXI in Pasco, WA, May 20th - 22nd, 2016 at the Pasco Red Lion. *"Never Alone, Never Again"*

10. PNWCNA XXXIX is October 21st - 23rd, 2016, at the Hilton Bellevue Hotel, in Bellevue, WA. *"Healing Our Spirit"*

11. At RSC there was a motion regarding Regional Delegates reimbursement for WSC. Working on a re-write of what was proposed in the CAR last year, intent is to ensure that poorer regions are able to attend World. Straw pole supported going forward with the re-write of the motion.

12. RSC Elections (there are always elections going on at RSC!) Tom, RSC IT Chair (running again but not present), Logan, RSC H & I Chair (running again but not present) Held over to next RSC, along with RSC Activities Chair. Barb was voted in as RSC Treasurer, and Leah as RSC Treasurer Trainee.

13. The RD's presented a motion to put in a subject guide for *"Living Clean"* (*Living Clean Pamphlet? Provide online? Would it change the cost of the book to republish?* (Straw vote passed to go forward with this - more will be revealed.)

14. Area inventories were discussed. Ray, RSC PI Chair, shared that the PI handbook has a great "Area Inventory" in it. Something our area might want to do in the future? We would need an outside facilitator.
